



## AUS GUIDELINE

### Prizes

2016

Prizes for performance at an Australian University Sport (AUS) event may **not** be awarded in the form of cash or equivalent (eg. bank account, cheque etc).

Prizes in the form of goods, trophies and the like may be awarded under the following conditions:

- a) Organisers must present AUS medals and trophies (where applicable) to successful participants in line with the [AUS awards and pointscoreing for events guideline](#).
- b) Unless otherwise approved by the AUS Board, no prize of value greater than \$1,000 may be awarded at an AUS event.
- c) Prizes may only be awarded if donated by sponsors. Entry fees and organiser resources must not be used to provide prizes. Any cash donated by sponsors should be used to offset event costs and reduce entry fees, not to purchase prizes.
- d) Prizes must not includes gifts (or gift cards) relating to alcoholic beverages or gambling products.
- e) Organisers have a responsibility to ensure that prizes presented are appropriate and reflect positively on the event and AUS in general.
